
1. Precrease along the diagonal with a mountain fold.




2. Valley fold the sides to the center.




3. Mountain fold the corner behind.




4. Open out the sides.




5. Valley fold the corner to the dotted crease. Allow the flap from behind to flip out.




6. Swing the flap back to the previous position.




7. Repeat steps 5-6 in mirror image.




8. Valley fold the corner to the dotted intersection of creases.




9. Precrease along the existing creases (adding new folds on the top flap).




10. Reverse fold along the existing creases.




11. Valley fold the corner down.




12. Valley fold towards the bottom corner, allowing the rear flap to flip out.




13. Swing over the top flap.




14. Precrease the middle along the angle bisector.




15. Valley fold through the dotted intersection of creases.




16. Squash fold over along the center.




17. Bring the corner to the top, allowing the sides to spread apart and lie flat.




18. Valley fold down, allowing the hidden flap to squash fold flat.




19. Pull out the trapped corner.




20. Pull out the middle layer.




21. Swing the flap up.




22. Valley fold the flap up.




23. Valley fold along the angle bisector.




24. Swing the flap down.




25. Reverse fold the flap up.




26. Valley fold over while squash folding the corner.




27. Squash fold the flap.




28. Valley fold the flap over.




29. Mountain fold the corner.




30. Swivel fold the side inside.




31. Pleat the flap so it lies symmetrically.




32. Valley fold up, starting a small amount above 1/3rd the height of the flap.




33. Valley fold the corner to the bottom edge.




34. Tuck the flap underneath the top layer.




35. Bring the bottom flap to the surface.




36. Mountain fold the flap so it aligns with the dotted corner of the hidden flap.




37. Mountain fold the corners inside.
