




Paper Recommendation

8 right angled isosceles triangular units. Cut along the diagonals of the square to obtain the triangular units.

Unit




1. Bring the corner to the centre.

One unit.
Make 7 more.


Note

Alternatively, the units can be pre-created, but it is not necessary. However, to do that, fold each unit till step 3 of Assembly; and then continue assembling as shown.


Assembly




1. Take 2 units at 45° to each other. Wrap the second unit over the first.




2. Gently lift the flap on the left and fold along the crease marked.




3. This is how it looks. Fold the flap down. Mountain fold along the crease marked.




4. This is how it looks. Turn over.




5. This is how it looks on the reverse. Turn over.




6. Add the third unit and repeat steps 1-3




7. The third unit is now joined. Turn over.





8. The reverse should look like this. Make sure the little flap goes under the paper (Marked by dotted lines).



9. Continue adding the remaining 5 units in a similar manner. Don't forget to shift layers when adding the last unit.



10. This is how it looks on the reverse after joining all the units. Insert the little flap (in circle) under the paper.
