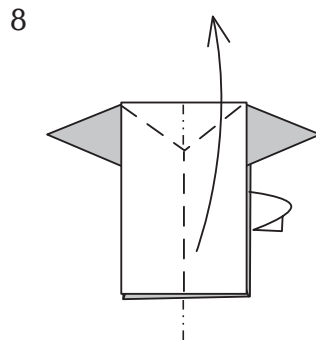
Rabbit-ear.



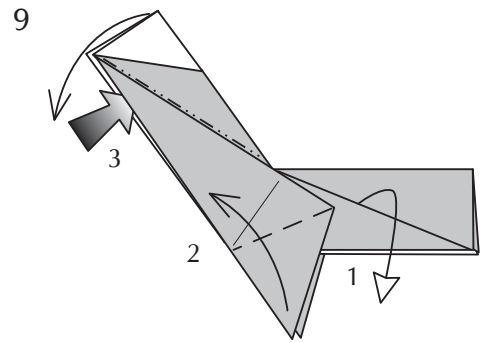

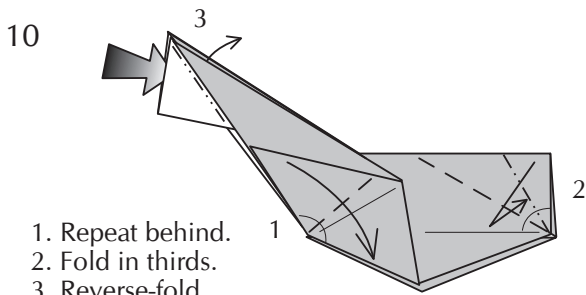

Spread the flaps on the left and right while folding in half. The dots will meet.



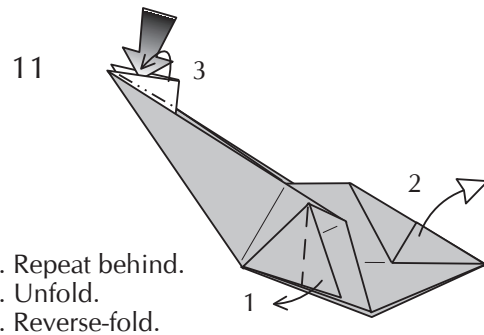

Lift the top layer up while folding in half. Rotate.



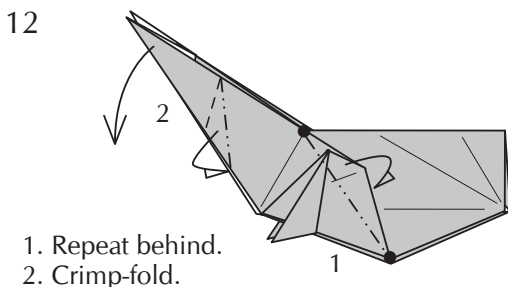
