



Tony O'Hare - Brief biog


- Origami artist now living in Monmouth.
- Folded paper since childhood
- Joined the British Origami Society in 1975
- Chair of the BOS from 2016 2022
- Have created hundreds of my own designs on various subjects
- 4 booklets of my original work published by the BOS.
- Focus on the natural world and subjects close to home, often with a humorous angle to them e.g. origami scenes of Bristol and associated subjects such as Wallace & Gromit and Shaun the Sheep.

Why tell the story of the Origami Bristol Calendar?


- 40 years in the making the story of a creative journey
- Moved out of Bristol Feb 2023 so finished just in time!
- Self-indulgence, tell my origami story
- Question often asked "How do you design or think up models?"
 Answer "I fold what's around me".
- Local/ themed subjects are popular (locally?)
- Some scenes not known outside Bristol, however Bristol has some reputation – in UK and abroad e.g. W&G (Aardman Animations), Banksy, Concorde, IK Brunel (cover, April, July, December), John Cabot (Feb, May), H.O. Wills, Cameron Balloons, Colston's statue (addendum...)
- Provoke some discussion & ideas!





Other origami calendars etc

- Not a unique concept e.g.
 - Bowater Scott, BOS Calendars etc
 - Themed books e.g. Momotani flowers, Planes, Boats & Trains etc
 - Mark Bolitho's "London Origami" book
 - Idea of a Bristol theme started with Cabot 500 Exhibition 1997 at Bristol Library photos?
 - BOS booklet no 63 "Shipshape & Bristol Fashion" (only the Clifton Suspension Bridge for the cover survives from Cabot 500 exhibition & Ship-shape into the Calendar)
 - Bristol BOS Conventions last one in 2006 (photos?), previously 2004, 2002, 1999, 1997, 1994, 1990, 1979.





General ideas for calendar


- 2D models
- "clean" folds
- Stylised or cartoon images
- some humour
- simple/intermediate complexity
- Multi-piece
- Scenes rather than "models" artistic?
- Variety of paper: including standard kami, chiyogami, Yoshizawa Special Origami paper (photos), copier paper (white/coloured), wrapping paper, poster paper, mounting board etc
- sticky tape & glue!
- Base on "classic" examples of photo or image of the actual scene (photos?)































Design & folding - month by month

- Jan August scenes were all folded and exhibited at BOS Con 2006 at Bristol.
- November: Wallace & Gromit taught at BOS Convention Autumn 2013 (Edinburgh), but this version folded for private commission c 2017.
- Bristol Balloons (for cover, different from August scene) designed 2019, taught at BOS Vcon Autumn 2020
- October: Banksy taught at OUSA Convention 2022
- September: Bristol Rovers shirt & Trad T-shirt
- December: Clifton Suspension Bridge new stylised version subsequently taught at BOS Convention Spring 2023 (Milton Keynes)
- Cover last scene to be compiled. Added bits to Suspension Bridge scene from 2006.

- Trad/ variation of Toshie Takahama's Yacht from Robert Harbin's "Step by Step Origami"
- Trad football shirt for Bristol City, variation for Rovers
- Letters for cover traditional?
- Photos by Robin Macey (2006), Grace Walsh, Tony O'Hare
- Tie each scene in with a month of the year notable dates, Wikipedia, Google etc. No suitable notable dates for Jan (St Mary Redcliffe Church) & Feb (Cabot Tower) so filled "gaps" in calendar.





Printing calendar & cards

- Printing self-produced small number via Photobox. Managable process & cost.
- Produce in time for Autumn/ Xmas arts & craft fairs e.g. North Bristol Arts Trail
- Cards from the Calendar (singles from the album):
 - Cover (printed via Photobox),
 - SSGB, Banksy & W&G (2013 version) printed via local printer Mockingbird Print, Bristol.
 - Bristol Balloons (2019 version), Clifton Suspension Bridge x 2 versions - coloured & B/W, and football shirts - origami-only cards
 - Have to consider time spent/ costs/ sale price.








What next?
