
In 2008, Victoria's secret issued an octagonal gift-box with a spiral closure stabilized by a piece of ribbon, which made quite a buzz in the origami community.


Offered here is an origami-compliant, self-closing version. Sexy lingerie optional.


Duo paper, heavier than kami

6" (15 cm) square makes a 2"x2" (5x5 cm) box


Pop-down locking mechanism invented by Philip Chapman-Bell


































Strengthen valley folds Model is no more flat




Collapse top of the box

Do not flatten the extra paper on the top




Top view
