


(Monotone paper preferred)
Begin with a triangle from half
of a square. Valley-fold and
unfold, then flip over.




Pick up the center crease and fold it to the edge to bisect the angle.




Valley-fold the top layer down and unfold.




Pick up the center crease and fold it to the edge.



Valley-fold the top layer and unfold.




Pick up the center crease and fold it to the edge.



To add more levels, continue to repeat this process starting at step 3.



Gently stretch the design out to make it 3D and rest it on its side.



The model is now complete!
