Originally designed in the early 70's, this beautiful and elegant model has, as far as I know, previously never been released, taken from her original sketches which were collected as part of my work toward producing a retrospective of Crawford's work which I'd agreed to do for her back when I arranged permission to reproduce her work when *Creating Origami* was originally published. I've included the original sketches of the model to add flavor to the history of this charming design.









Swing one flap to the left and others to the right leaving two to the left.

Sink hexagonally, keeping two flaps on the right folded under as indicated in the next step.


Mid-fold, note indicated places to keep paper pinched together.






Repeat last 3 steps

Fin is slightly 3d




Tuck lower layers under hidden, upper layer.



Tuck another flap inside to complete dorsal fin and swing lower fins up.

Tuck lower layers inside, hide rear flaps inside (like above) and do crimp-like fold to create the dorsal fin.



Make 3d, curl tail, etc.


